SYNOPSIS:

Recent advances in our understanding of oxygen transport in the brain suggests that ischemia and hypoxia are very different disease entities. The lectures provides an overview of these findings, and discusses whether tissue hypoxia may exist despite normal perfusion, and whether ischemia is the least problem of our patients as we seek to reperfuse tissue during acute stroke.
